SPECTATORS: THE BEST PLACE TO BE ALONG THE COURSE!

- > **Bois d'Amont – Start:** a festive atmosphere in the heart of the village for the start of the Transju' long events. With the presence of our partner Salomon!
- > **Bellefontaine:** the first refreshment-station after passing the Risoux massif, atmosphere and competitive performance will be assured with the first intermediate sprint.
- > **Chapelle des Bois:** a second refreshment-station and passage through the village to the sound of cowbells and encouragements. Second intermediate sprint.
- > **Combe des Cives:** admire the passage of the competitors along the road (no stopping along the road).
- > **Au Pré-Poncet:** at this refreshment-station the racers will pass over the road via the footbridge.
- > **Chapelle des Bois:** a double refreshment-station will guarantee animation with racers coming and going, plus the excitement with the third intermediate sprint. An ideal spot to see a maximum number of skiers for the Transju'Classic, La Transjurassienne and the Trans'Marathon.
- > **Chaux-Neuve:** festive atmosphere with the finish at the foot of the jump hill: big-screen, local products and artisans, animations and competitive finishes!

### TRAFFIC RECOMMENDATIONS

Any traffic restrictions will be from 7am – 11:30am on Saturday & Sunday

One-way traffic flow with **parking along the right side of the road**. For more details: <http://latransju.com/faq-transju/>

Start area: the center of the village in **Bois d'Amont will be closed to traffic** the two days of the Transju' events.

The Route du Vivier will be maintained one-way in the direction Bois d'Amont-Les Rousses. Be aware that a section of the Route des Meuniers will be closed to all traffic between Les Meuniers and the village until the last racer has crossed the road.

To get to the finish in Chaux-Neuve from Bois d'Amont, you can also take the route through the Joux valley in Switzerland, Mouthe and on to Chaux-Neuve.

Parking areas are limited in the start and finish areas, **use the racer busses** whenever possible. CAREFUL! THE RISOUX FOREST IS A PROTECTED ZONE FORBIDDEN TO SPECTATORS!

### WEATHER

Light snow with passing sunny spells is predicted this weekend with temperatures between -1°C and -6°C.
